- E4C's Make Tax Time Pay program (MTTP) is a volunteer-run initiative that helps individuals and families with lower incomes to access free income tax preparation & benefit and subsidy applications
- People with lower incomes need to complete an income tax return in order to receive government rebates and benefits such as the City of Edmonton Leisure Access Pass, the Canada Child Tax Benefit, extended health care benefits, and child care subsidies
- E4C is the coordinating body that partners with volunteers, colleges, agencies, churches, community organizations, businesses, and government departments to provide this positive program in our city.
- E4C's MTTP tax sites operate every March & April. During the tax season call 2-1-1 (The Support Network) to get connected to a tax site near you

2009-2010 Client Data

- We operated 22 volunteer-run, free income tax preparation sites in March & April
- We had over 250 committed MTTP volunteers
- We completed over 4,100 income tax returns
- We helped our service users access over \$1.1 Million in income tax refunds
- We helped our service users access over 1,350 government benefits and subsidies
- The benefit that was most accessed was the City of Edmonton Leisure Access Pass
- The majority of our service users reported that their main source of income was employment
- 22% of 2010 MTTP service users were returning from last year
- We assisted over 850 families with children
