### **Residential Youth Worker- Part-Time, Crossroads House**

#### **Key Responsibilities & Duties:**

As a Residential Youth Worker, your primary responsibility will be to provide care and programming to residents and to maintain a safe and healthy living environment at Crossroads House.

Duties include: providing social support and crisis intervention to residents, assisting residents with basic living skills and programming such as education and recreation, supervising facility health and safety and promoting resident cooperation, record keeping and other administrative duties as needed.

Crossroads House is an intensive supportive housing setting for high risk youth and youth who may have experienced sexual exploitation, and may be identified as children in need of services under the Protection of Sexually Exploited Children Act.

#### **Qualifications:**

Preferred candidates will have:

- Strong interpersonal skills and the ability to relate to and work with youth
- Post-secondary training in human services and related experience
- Criminal Record clearance and Child Welfare Information Systems clearance
- Knowledge of child and youth development, addiction, mental health, homelessness and/or aboriginal issues
- Valid Driver's License and access to personal vehicle

#### **Position:**

- Part-time position up to 20 hours weekly.
- Shift work covering afternoons, evenings, nights and weekends.
