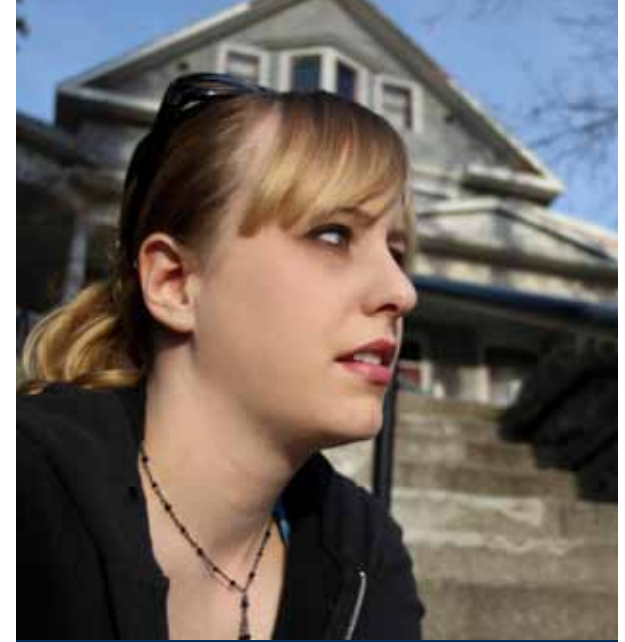

E4C's Case Management Team (CMT) uses a housing first model and provides comprehensive supports to assist chronically homeless individuals to attain and maintain long-term affordable housing. Service users are assisted with accessing essentials such as financial supports, medical attention, legal advice, employment opportunities or public transportation. This gives individuals a foundation on which they can make informed decisions to advance their lives towards self-sufficiency, feel better about themselves and become more effective participants in their communities.

Since opening in 2008, staff have housed 86 adults and 14 children and continue to make great strides in assisting a portion of our community which is often neglected.

The program provides wrap around support services which include on-to-one outreach support, 24 hour on-call availability, regular follow up, and flexing work schedules to better meet the needs of our services users.



SERVICES PROVIDED

Housing

- Securing housing and obtaining furniture, household goods, damage deposits, payment of utilities and utility hook ups
- Housing maintenance through regular home visits
- Liaising with landlords to ensure housing stability
