A Youth Employment and Education Program



What is the Kids in the Hall Bistro Program?

The Kids in the Hall Bistro Program helps at-risk youth aged 16-24 gain the knowledge and skills necessary to be successful in an educational or employment setting. Many of the youth enrolled in the program come from unstable home environments and are facing multiple barriers to success.



The program uses paid work and on-the-job training to help youth reach their goals. Giving youth this kind of experience in a viable restaurant, combined with other support has led to a high success rate. Youth leave the program with secure employment or to continue their education.

Program graduates have concrete work experience, life skills, competency in various food service industry roles, and basic understandings of business practices. They are also taught to take responsibility for their own career development, have increased self-esteem and a higher sense of self-worth.

What are the Education Services?

Our partnership with the Edmonton Catholic School Board's Fresh Start Outreach High School, gives us the opportunity to have a teacher meet with program and outreach youth three times a week right at the Bistro.



Running classes, workshops and outreach at the bistro allows for easier access to school for youth working there. Balancing work, education and a social life is imperative in teaching youth structure and responsibility. Applying these behaviors properly are a major building block to success in life.

How are services accessed?

All youth service requests—ranging from referrals to community resources, accessing Fresh Start or entering into employment training at the bistro—are through the Kids in the Hall Outreach program. This process allows staff to work with youth to determine their needs and break the cycle of dependence and poverty.

Where is the Kids in the Hall Bistro Located?

Kids in the Hall Bistro is a vibrant downtown Edmonton bistro located in City Hall, that serves an eclectic upscale casual menu in a comfortable restaurant. The Bistro has great food and excellent service all at an affordable price. It is open for breakfast and lunch Monday to Friday from 8 am to 3 pm.

By eating at Kids in the Hall Bistro you are helping youth in Edmonton gain the experience and skills necessary to be successful in life.
