Job Purpose

The McCauley Community Clean Up is an annual one day “Big Bin” event hosted by E4C’s McCauley apartments, in partnership with the McCauley Community League, the City of Edmonton., and other community agencies. On this day members of the McCauley Community are invited to come to this event and dispose of loads of large unwanted household items in order to prevent these items from cluttering up our alleyways. We also offer a service in which community members may pre-register for a pick up, and volunteers come to the resident’s home and remove one truckload of refuse for disposal. This entire event is offered free of charge to the community, and we require many volunteers to make this event a success.

Duties and Responsibilities

The litter collectors travel in teams of 2 to 4 people and pick up smaller litter and trash from the McCauley Community’s streets and parks. Safety supplies and the required tools are provided to the volunteers to carry out this task.
