What is Make Tax Time Pay?

Make Tax Time Pay is a volunteer-based program that provides individuals and families with lower incomes with:

1. Free income tax preparation
2. Information and applications on government benefits & subsidies including:
 - Goods & Services Tax Credit (GST)
 - Canada Child Tax Benefit
 - City of Edmonton, Leisure Access Pass
 - Child care subsidies
 - Alberta Adult/Child Health Benefit
 - Information on Registered Education Savings Plans (RESP) grants
 - Information on seniors benefits



Who qualifies for Make Tax Time Pay?

We prepare income tax returns and provide information and applications on government benefits for individuals and families who qualify. Our program follows the Canada Revenue Agency-Community volunteer Income Tax Program's income cut-off guidelines. These guidelines are updated annually.

Why do you need to complete your income tax return?

Individuals and families need to file their income tax returns to qualify for and receive the government benefits and subsidies listed on the left. These benefits and subsidies can decrease the costs associated with health care, child care and recreational activities for our service users.

Where and when do we operate tax sites?

Our community-based Make Tax Time Pay sites operate across Edmonton in many locations through the tax months of March and April. If you would like to book an appointment in March or April, please call 2-1-1 (The Support Network) for a Make Tax Time Pay site near you!



How do we do it?

We partner with our community. We work with hundreds of caring individuals, community organizations, churches and non-profits that take time to come together to make this program possible. We would not have the success we do without the valued partnerships of the City of Edmonton, 2-1-1, the Government of Alberta and the Canada Revenue Agency-Community Volunteer Income Tax Program.
