What is the Northeast Community Program?

The Northeast Community Program is an after-school program working with children to help them gain skills, make friends and have fun.

Formerly known as the Northeast Teen Drop-in Centre, the program has been running youth-based programming since 1991. We reach at-risk children and youth providing them with social supports and preventative programming.

- Build healthy friendships
- Learn to make goals
- Learn to speak up
- Have fun with friends
- Work as a team



Goals of the Program:

- Reinforce basic social skills, such as cooperation, team building, and conflict resolution to help children begin to develop work place competencies
- Improve academic achievement in children
- Increase student's self-esteem through skill development activities
- Provide a safe environment
- Encourage and develop links and partnerships between school, home and community
- Assist children between 8 to 13 years, in at-risk and underserved communities

Since 2008, the Northeast Community Program has reached over 50 children. It has helped increase their knowledge on issues surrounding bullying, stress management, positive conflict resolution, self-esteem, nutrition, home safety, addictions and abuse.

The Northeast Community Program has been working in Bannerman Elementary School in northeast Edmonton with children aged 8 to 13 years old.

The program is provided to schools in undeserved, resource-poor communities in the Northeast area of Edmonton.
